What is the Vigo and what can it do?

The Vigo is a bluetooth headset that

- ⦿ gives back the ability to users to **control** their power wheelchairs **with ease**
- ⦿ can also be used as a **head mouse**
- ⦿ works with simple head movements
- ⦿ is a **proportional** control device



The Vigo's advantages

- ◎ **wireless** headset - no cables blocking the head movement
- ◎ **unobtrusive** - nothing is obscuring the person's face or their vision
- ◎ **intuitive**, easy to learn - people may quickly get the hang of it (10-15 minutes)
- ◎ **lightweight** - with the headband it only weighs 37 g
- ◎ highly **customizable** - its working range can be adjusted to the most restricted of abilities via the downloadable softwares
- ◎ works with most specialty control interfaces - Omni/Omni2, IOM, Linx DLX-IN500, Q-Logic 3 EX

Who is it for?

For people

- ⊙ with limited or no hand functionality
- ⊙ living with tetraplegia, tetraparesis, spinal injury, progressive diseases (SM, ALS), muscular dystrophy
- ⊙ looking for alternatives to chin joysticks or head arrays
- ⊙ wishing to regain independent control of their computers and devices
